

Black Belt Candidate Testing Criteria

- 1. Completed Graduation Application.
- 2. Recommendation from all teachers, parents, and or employer.
- 3. Recommendation from two close friends (adults only).
- 4. Student must write an essay on what black belt means to them, what training has done for them, and why they feel they deserve a black belt. This is <u>not</u> an acceptance speech, please keep the thank you's to a minimum. (If thank you's are included in the essay please be prepared to cut them out during the speech given at the test). Essay must be 500-1000 words double spaced and typed. Speech must <u>not</u> be longer than 5 minutes. Student must be prepared to recite the Essay in speech form. Do not forget to thank ALL that helped you on your journey.
- 5. All Self Defense and grappling techniques must be demonstrated with precision, power, and enthusiasm.
- 6. All techniques learned from white belt up must be performed with proficiency. This includes all strikes, blocks, kicks, stances, etc.
- 7. A four station board break must be performed. The candidate receives three tries at each break. If the candidate does not succeed in breaking a particular station within the allotted three attempts, then he/she will not continue with the test. The techniques for each break, the number of boards to be used, and the size of the boards, must all be approved by Sensei prior to the test.
- 8. The candidate must be prepared to take a written test on what they have learned from the beginning. This test will be administered at Sensei's discretion.
- 10. If applicable, the candidate must have a "B" average in school with no "D"s or "F"s. Most recent report card must be submitted with the candidate's report prior to the test.
- 11. The candidate must wear a clean pressed uniform with all current, proper patches. The student's name must appear on the left lapel. All sleeves must be cut just beneath the elbow. The candidate's belt must be tied properly. Proper uniform is part of the discipline of the Martial Arts.

IMPORTANT

The candidate will be evaluated on all aspects of the Martial Arts; discipline, confidence, dedication, attitude, and the winning, non-quitting spirit it takes to become a Black Belt.

Please note that 3 mistakes in any category=failed category. Any failed category=re-test.



Leading Edge Martial Arts Black Belt Test Format

(Speeches will be given throughout the entire test.) Speeches are to be <u>no</u> longer than 5 minutes.

Section 1:

Push ups— 25 for students testing for Jr. Black Belt

50 for students testing for 1st Degree Black Belt 100 for students testing for 2nd Degree Black Belt

Section 2:

1. Hand techniques

Section 3:

1. Kicking Techniques

Section 4:

1. Kicking ranges

Section 5:

1. Fighting Combinations

Section 6:

1. Self-Defense

*Students testing for 1st degree black belt must also have alternates for each self-defense prepared

Section 7:

1. Octagon

*Students must be able to describe the octagon. They will also be tested on moving on the octagon, and countering the attacks.

Leading Edge Martial Arts Black Belt Test Format Continued

Section 9:

Board Breaking:

Students must complete a 4 station board breaking.

After 3 attempts at any board, the student will take a break and then return to the break. The break must be completed within 5 minutes of the last candidate breaking his/her boards.

Section 10: Grappling

Students testing for Jr. Black Belt are required to complete: 3 one minute rounds. They will start on their knees and work for position, showing that they have an understanding of the concept of grappling.

Students testing for 1st Degree Black Belt are required to complete: Three 2 minute rounds. They will start on their knees and continue to submission.

Students testing for 2nd Degree Black Belt are required to complete: Three 3 minute rounds. They will start on their knees and continue to submission.

Section 11: Sparring

Students testing for Jr. Black Belt and 1st Degree Black Belt are required to complete: 10 one minute consecutive rounds.

Students testing for 2nd Degree Black Belt are required to complete: 15 one minute consecutive rounds.

*Candidates must be on the offense for all rounds. The candidate gets one warning for lack of offensive technique. If he/she is warned a second time, they do not continue with the test.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>

All candidates are evaluated on all aspects of the martial arts. Discipline, confidence, dedication, attitude, and the winning, non-quitting spirit it takes to become a Black Belt.

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
